Chardonnay du Monde: Gold for Geneva

The 20th Chardonnay du Monde wine competition (<u>www.chardonnay-du-monde.com</u>) took place in Saint Lager, Burgundy, France, from March 13 to 16, 2013.

Only 33% of the wines tasted by a jury made up of tasters from around the world were awarded a medal at the competition. Results for Geneva wines were excellent: two gold medals (national record) and two silver medals.

The Cave de Genève won gold for its "Genève AOC La Nomade 2011" and its "Baccarat Blanc de Blancs Brut," while Les Perrières and Domaine Les Hutins won silver for their "Chardonnay de Peissy 2011" and "Coteaux de Dardagny AOC 1er Cru Barrique" respectively.

With its 17 medals, three of them gold, Switzerland came in second of all participating countries.
