

## Six Silver Medals for Six Geneva Wines in Paris

All the Geneva wines submitted to the 19<sup>th</sup> Vinalies Internationales wine competition were awarded medals – a result that highlights the great diversity of the canton's wines.

Over the course of five tasting mornings at the Vinalies competition in Paris, from March 1 to 5, 2013, 137 tasters sampled 3,425 wines.

The Vinalies competition takes place under the patronage of the Paris-based intergovernmental International Organisation of Vine and Wine.

This year, Geneva won six silver medals for a "Merlot de Peissy en fût de chêne 2011" and "Premier cru Château de Choully 2011" produced by Les Perrières; "Gamaret Mandragore 2010" produced by Domaine du Clos des Pins; "Pont des Soupirs 2011" produced by the Domaine du Paradis; and "Sauvignon Blanc l'Aiglette 2011" produced by the Cave de Genève.
